George Austen
(1766-1838)
*mentally
handicapped and
kept away from the

Edward Austen
(1767-1852)
*known as Edward
Knight after 1812
m.
Elizabeth Bridges,
and had eleven
children, of whom the
eldest,
Fanny-Catherine
(b.1793) was a
favourite with Jane
Austen*

**Henry-Thomas
Austen**
(1771-1850)
*bankrupt in 1816 and
subsequently curate
of Chawton*

Eliza Hancock
(1761-1813)
*m.
(1) Jean de Feullide
(guillotined in 1794),
and had one son,
Hastings, (1786-1801);
(2) Henry Austen and
had no further children*

**Cassandra-Elizabeth
Austen**
(1773-1845)
did not marry

Francis-William Auste
(1774-1865)
*known as "Frank"
m.
(1) Mary Gibson, and
had eleven children;
(2) Martha Lloyd, anc
had no further childre.*

*m.

had four children;
(2) Harriet Palmer
(Frances's sister)*
